

Accommodation Strategies for Students with Disabilities in the Classroom

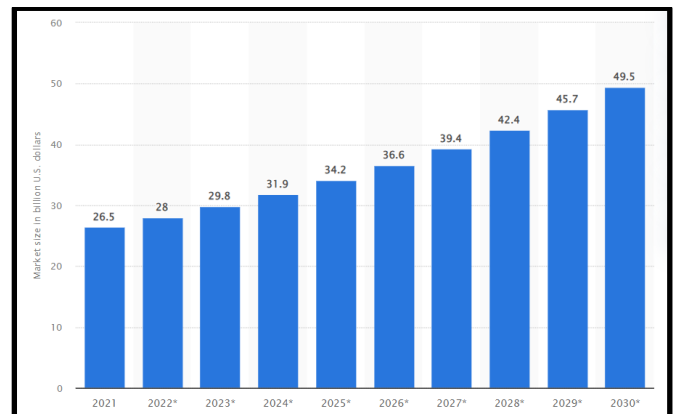


Figure 1: Global market of disabled assessing technologies (2021-2030) [18]
